Semester Contribution	All students must pay a semester fee of approximately 360 euros per semester. It also includes a ticket for free local public transport throughout Germany (!) and allows for discounted meals in the university canteen.
Accommodation	EvH Bochum does not run its own student dormitory but the International Office assists incoming students in finding accommodation in Bochum.
Cost of Living	Students should have approximately 870 Euro per month: rent: 400 Euro; food: 180 Euro; health insurance: 130 Euro; telephone/internet: 30 Euro; books, clothing, leisure, travels: 130 Euro

Student Assistants	Students of EvH Bochum (student assistants) will help exchange students with general questions during their stay and offer a welcome programme.
Special Needs	EvH Bochum offers facilities for students and staff with special needs. The International Office will help incoming students to get in touch with the respective contact persons. All facilities are wheelchair-accessible.
English Programme	Every summer semester, EvH Bochum offers an English-language semester programme – our so-called International Semester Programme (ISP). The offer is specifically aimed at students in the fields of social work, diversity, welfare, inclusion and related areas. It enables the acquisition of up to 30 CPs and provides insights from academic, practical and artistic perspectives. Why the EvH RWL?	The EvH Bochum is the largest protestant institution of higher education in Germany.
